Feature	Detail for Pupils and Parents
Pupils are asked not to come onto the school site until 8am, at which point they will need to go directly to their registration room.	There is an additional annex to the behaviour policy in place which pupils will be required to follow to enable them to understand and follow the new adaptations.
Temperature checks may operate for all.	This will not be the case when we open but we will be reviewing this on a weekly basis.
One-way systems will be introduced where these are possible and practical and we may make use of rotas to enter and leave buildings.	<p>Full details will be explained to pupils and site signage put in place.</p> <p>Desks will face forwards in classrooms where possible.</p>
Year group bubbles	<p>We have established dedicated year group areas in a number of locations around the site using marquees. These marquees will be clearly marked and pupils should be in these locations at break times and lunch time if they are not in the dining hall or involved in an organised club.</p> <p>Pupils in the L4, U4, LR and UR will need to only use their dedicated year group area for the purpose of storing their bags during break and lunchtime. Pupils in these year groups will need to take their bags to their registration area as well as lessons. Pupils in the Fifth and Sixth Form may use the following designated bag racks:</p> <p>Music School/Side of CMR – FF Old Climbing Wall/Geography Apex – L6 Dining Hall/Annett building/Outside Keyes Building – U6</p> <p>In order to limit the interaction between pupils in different year groups, pupils will only be able to use designated toilets according to their year group:</p> <p>Keyes Building – FF, L6 and U6 School House – LR and UR Annett Building – L4 and U4</p>
We may ask that clothing, such as shirts and blouses, which is worn one day not be worn again before washing within a specific time-frame.	This is not presently the case so pupils and staff are able to attend School in their normal uniform.
Pupils will be required to attend school wearing their PE kit on days they have PE and Games and changing rooms will be out of use.	PE kit may include plain navy-blue track suit bottoms in place of the school track suit bottoms.

Online learning may be delivered alongside lessons in classrooms and pupils in the senior school will need to bring a device with them to school.	<p>To enable continuity in teaching and learning as well as facilitate the limited need for papers and materials to pass between pupil and teacher, we ask that each pupil bring with them a device. Families should ensure that they have insurance cover for the device for loss or damage whilst in School. Headphones for this device will also be required.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils in L4, U4, LR, UR, FF should bring a WIFI enabled smartphone. The use of a tablet or laptop should be with the recommendation of Learning Skills and only to support specific learning needs. • Pupils in L6 and U6 may bring a tablet or iPad but a smartphone will suffice.

	<p>The use of a device in any lesson will be at the direction of the teacher. More information will be available to remind pupils of the Acceptable Use Policy (AUP).</p> <p>In order for a pupil device to be used in any lesson within the school day, pupils must manage their devices to ensure the battery will last through the whole day.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils should be familiar with settings on their device to prolong battery life such as screen dimming. • The device must be fully charged at the start of the school day. • Pupils may need to alter their online habits on the way to School to maintain a full battery. • Pupils are not allowed to bring in a 3-pin charger. • A portable charging device may be brought into School to top up their battery during the school day.
Equipment will not be shared between pupils, other than when appropriate cleaning has taken place and therefore pupils must bring their own stationery, as well as specified PE equipment. No lab coats or art overalls will be borrowed.	<p>In order to not share items of stationery, we ask that every pupil attend School each day with the following items:</p> <p>Pens; Pencils; Ruler; Rubber; Pencil sharpener; Pair of scissors; Glue stick; Calculator</p> <p>For all pupils in L4, U4 and LR as well as those studying GCSE or Pre-U Art: Black fine liner pens (a pack of three for £1 from The Works would be ideal) 2B, 4B, 6B graphite drawing pencils An additional rubber</p>
Most work will be submitted by online.	Work marked 'by hand' will make use of 'quarantine' periods to reinforce the safety of all.
The Library will be out of general use.	Sixth Form study periods will be scheduled for pupils, some of which will take place in the Library. The Library will be available on a rota basis for all so that pupils can exchange books.
Vending Machines will not be in use.	Pupils will need to bring in their own breacktime snacks.
A revised catering offering will be in place.	<p>On account of restrictions on space, pupils bringing in a packed lunch will eat in their dedicated year group area. The dining hall will not provide a service for breakfast, break or after school.</p> <p>Water fountains can be used to fill water bottles only. Pupils must bring their own water bottle to school.</p>
Town privileges will be initially suspended or subject to amendment.	<p>Pupils in the L4 to FF are required to remain on the school site throughout the school day.</p> <p>L6 pupils may go into town at lunchtimes on Mondays and Fridays, however, and U6 pupils may go into town at lunchtimes on Tuesdays and Thursdays.</p>
Some assemblies and large briefings will be delivered online.	
Some co-curricular opportunities will be delivered online.	The Autumn Term Co-Curricular Programme will be shared with you during the second week of term.
Some cross year group after school co-curricular opportunities will operate in small, consistent groups throughout the activity session.	
Pupils not involved in co-curricular activities after school will need to be supervised in year group bubble locations.	Each year group will be located in a separate classroom in the Annett Building and pupils must stay in these designated areas to work: A5 – L4; A6 – U4; A7 – LR; A8 – UR; A1 – FF; A2 – L6; A3 – U6
