### MONDAY

**Fencing** Try (or improve) your hand at fencing, whether Olympic standard or complete beginner. All are welcome. Please turn up Mondays by 4pm in the Old Sports Hall (next to the swimming pool) wearing trainers, full length track-suit bottoms (or leggings) and a T-shirt or polo shirt. Equipment and coaching will be provided. If you can only manage one of the two hours that will be fine. You will be given further information to take home with you at the end of the session.
