



King's Hawford Kindergarten Fees from September 2023

Kindergarten is open for 50 weeks of the year (excluding bank holidays) from 7.45am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday. There is a termly inset for staff training.

The nursery is closed for all bank holidays and closed for one week at Christmas and one week in August.

There is a minimum requirement of 4 sessions weekly.

Parents have the option to book "All year round" or "Term Time only". Parents will be charged the same rate per day or session regardless of which option they choose. There are limited Term Time only spaces available.

The price includes lunch for the morning session and snacks and enrichments activities. These include:

- Forest School
- PE
- Swimming
- Cooking
- Music and movement

Additional Enrichment activities may be offered each term at additional cost. For example

- Rugby Tots
- Ballet

Late Charge: All children must be collected by 6:00pm. Please note, our day-care team work very hard to ensure that your child has a fantastic time and we reserve the right to charge an additional fee of £10 per child per 15 minutes for late pick up. The School reserves the right to make additional charges for persistent lateness.

Government Funding for 3 & 4 year olds - 15 Universal Hours

If your child is 3 or 4 they can access a funded early education place from the start of the school term after their 3rd birthday and until they reach statutory school age.

Children who turn 3 years of age between:	15 Free hours commence:
1 st April and 31 st August	1 st September – Autumn Term
1 st September and 31 st December	1 st January – Spring Term
1 st January and 31 st March	1 st April – Summer Term

At King's Hawford we offer:

'Term Time only' - up to 15 'Universal' hours per weeks during term time. Capped at 6 hours per full day and 3 hour per half day session.

15 hours funding allocation per week is capped at £70.50 or £14.10 per 3 hours session.

'All year round' – the full year entitlement of 570 'Universal' hours stretched over 50 weeks, which is 11.4 hours per week. Capped at 6 hours per full day and 3 hour per half day session.

11.4 hours funding allocation per week is capped at £53.58 or £14.10 per 3 hours session.

There is a charge for the additional hours, enrichment activities and services outside the scope of these funded hours.

We do not offer 30 hours funding at King's Hawford Kindergarten.

We are not registered for government funding for 2 year olds.

Early Years Pupil Premium

The Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) and Special Needs Funding will also be applied for according to individual circumstances.
