



## King's Hawford Kindergarten Fees from September 2024

Kindergarten is open for 50 weeks of the year (excluding bank holidays) from 7.45am - 6.00pm Monday - Friday. There is a termly inset for staff training.

The nursery is closed for all bank holidays, plus one week at Christmas and one week in August.

There is a minimum requirement of 4 sessions weekly.

Parents have the option to book "All Year Round" or "Term Time Only" and will be charged the same rate per day or session, regardless of which option they choose. There is limited availability for Term Time Only contracts.

**The price includes lunch for the morning session plus snacks and enrichments activities. These include:**

- Forest School
- PE
- Swimming
- Cooking
- Music and movement
- Visits to the school library bus
- Access to a dedicated Early Years Garden
- Countryside Walks
- Educational visits

**Late Charge:** All children must be collected by 6.00pm. Please note, our day-care team work very hard to ensure that your child has a fantastic time, and we reserve the right to charge an additional fee of £10 per child per 15 minutes for late pick up. The school reserves the right to make additional charges for persistent lateness.

### Government Funding for 2-year-olds

From April 2024, eligible 2-year-olds will be entitled to 15 hours funded childcare per week. To see if you meet the criteria and apply for a code please follow this link:

Funded hours are available **within** a normal session between 9am to 12pm and 2.30pm to 5.30pm. You will need to have a valid code **before** the start of the term you wish to claim funding for. **It is parents' responsibility to keep their codes valid by reconfirming every 3 months.**

**Term Time Only** - up to 15 hours per week during term time for working parents. Capped at 6 hours per full day and 3 hours per half day session.

**15 hours funding allocation per week is capped at £105.75 or £21.15 per 3-hour session**

**All Year Round** - the full year entitlement of 570 hours stretched over 50 weeks, which is 11.4 hours per week. Capped at 6 hours per full day and 3 hours per half day session.

**11.4 hours funding allocation per week is capped at £80.37 or £21.15 per 3-hour session**

There is a charge for the additional hours, enrichment activities and services outside the scope of these funded hours.

### **Government Funding for 3 & 4-year-olds - 15 Universal Hours**

All children are eligible for 15 hours of funded early education per week from the term after their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday.

**Completion of a Parent declaration Form is required before funding can be claimed.**

### **Government Funding for 3 & 4-year-olds - 15 Extended Hours**

Working parents of 3 & 4-year-olds may be entitled to an additional 15 hours of funding per week. To check eligibility criteria and apply for your code please follow this link:

You will need to have a valid code **before** the start of the term you wish to claim the additional hours.

**It is parents' responsibility to keep their codes valid by reconfirming every 3 months.**

**Term Time Only** - up to 30 hours per week during term time. Capped at 6 hours per full day and 3 hours per half day session.

**15 hours funding allocation per week is capped at £76.35 or £15.27 per 3-hour session**

**30 hours funding allocation per week is capped at £152.70 or £15.27 per 3-hour session**

**All Year Round** - the full year entitlement of 570/1140 hours stretched over 50 weeks, which is 11.4/22.8 hours per week. Capped at 6 hours per full day and 3 hours per half day session.

**11.4 hours funding allocation per week is capped at £58.03 or £15.27 per 3-hour session**

**22.8 hours funding allocation per week is capped at £116.06 or £15.27 per 3-hour session**

There is a charge for the additional hours, enrichment activities and services outside the scope of these funded hours.

**Early Years Pupil Premium**

The Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) and Special Needs Funding will also be applied for according to individual circumstances.
