Everyone is helpful at King's and will point you in the right direction. We've all been lost, so we know it can seem scary – just ask for help!



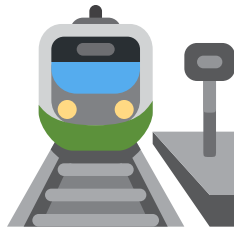
DON'T WORRY ABOUT MAKING FRIENDS!

Try and talk to everyone in your Year group, even if you feel shy, and join up for lots of clubs and activities. You'll meet lots of people through trying out new things.



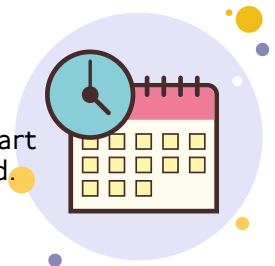
PRACTISE YOUR JOURNEY TO SCHOOL.
