

Dear Parents and Guardians,

As part of our ongoing commitment to providing the best possible education for our pupils, we are currently reviewing our provision for Personal, Social, Health, Citizenship and Economic Education (PSHCE), including Relationships and Sex Education (RSE), at King's Hawford. As such, we would be very grateful if you could take a few moments to complete a short survey to help us understand your views as part of this consultation process.

We regularly review and update our PSHCE and RSE provision to ensure it reflects both current guidance and the needs of our school community. After much research and careful consideration, we have made the decision to adopt a new whole-school PSHCE scheme developed by Kapow Primary. This comprehensive programme is fully aligned with the National Curriculum and includes age-appropriate RSE content.

The Kapow scheme is designed to be inclusive and adaptable. It reflects our school values, considers the age and maturity of our pupils, and is sensitive to cultural and religious backgrounds. The curriculum is framed around what children need to know to stay healthy, safe, and prepared for life in modern Britain—both in school, in their personal relationships, and in the wider world. It also meets all current Government guidelines and can be tailored to meet the specific needs of our pupils.

A key part of this curriculum includes age-appropriate elements of Relationships and Sex Education. Parents will continue to have the right to withdraw their child from any sex education content that is taught in Year 6 and falls outside the statutory National Curriculum for Science. However, please note that parents are not able to withdraw their child from the relationships and health education components, which are statutory.

We would really value your feedback on both our current provision and the proposed changes. Your responses will help us shape a curriculum that best meets the needs of all our pupils. You may find it helpful to review the attached resources before completing the questionnaire.

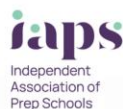
