### Communication Channels

Beginning this term, the school will no longer utilise the school app as a means of communication. Instead, all correspondence will be delivered via email. In addition, these communications will be archived within the Communication History section of the iSAMS Parent App, ensuring that you can access messages at your convenience.

We trust that this streamlined approach will support more effective and reliable communication between school and home.

### School Calendar

In alignment with the wider Foundation, we are also introducing a new digital school calendar. This calendar will be accessible via the school website and directly through the following link:

Once you have followed the link to the calendar, there is the opportunity to filter the entries by school and type, ensuring that if you have children across the Foundation you won't miss any important dates.

Furthermore, families will have the option to integrate the calendar with their personal digital calendars. A short instructional video will be provided to guide you through this process.

Class Dojo will still be used as in previous years, to share photo moments and updates from each class' week. We would ask that communication to teaching staff is via email only, and not through the Class Dojo platform.

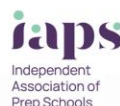
