I am delighted to introduce a new Drama and Performance opportunity for you child from September 2025. From Year 2, all children are invited to join LAMDA provision at King's Hawford.

LAMDA – What is it all about?

During the LAMDA programme students will learn about communication and performance skills. They will build a strong foundation that will improve their confidence in speaking and listening. These are the first stages of performance work that will aid their ability to memorise and recall information.

In the LAMDA sessions students will:

- Explore a range of poems and texts expanding their vocabulary and reading skills.
- Be encouraged to work with their favourite stories and bring their fictional heroes to life.
- Be required to work as part of a team as well as having the opportunity to shine on their own.
- LAMDA requires a committed individual who is capable of independent learning.
- Entry for an exam qualification is optional but encouraged.

- Develop your voice, diction and posture
- Be recognised for your talents
- Widen your vocabulary
- Foster your interest in drama
- Belong to part of a team

The LAMDA programme offers the pupils a rewarding and holistic experience that will not only develop their performance skills but also confidence, self-esteem and well-being.

LAMDA lessons are part of the peripatetic programme offered at King's Hawford and will be taught in pairs or trios depending on what is desired, most suitable for the children and the uptake of pupils.

Classes will take place on Mondays or Wednesdays and will work on a weekly rotation; the schedule will be sent to parents at the start of each week. Lessons will run for 30 minutes a week and will be charged termly in advance at £10.95 per lesson. The LAMDA course will be structured in three blocks corresponding to each of the school terms. There will be the option of an exam towards the end of the school year.

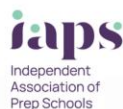
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
