



King's St Alban's Nursery Fees – April 2026

Term-time only provision

King's St Alban's Nursery is open Monday to Friday between 07.45 -18.00 and offers term-time only contracts in line with term dates across the King's Foundation. We are closed on all bank holidays plus one termly inset for staff training.

From April 2026 the following standard fee rates will apply:

Full day 07.45 - 18.00	Morning (including lunch) 07.45 - 12.00	Afternoon 12.00 - 18.00

We encourage booking a minimum of four sessions to help your child settle into a consistent routine (a full day being two sessions).

Morning sessions include lunch and a variety of specialised activities unique to our setting. These may include river walks, French lessons, music, PE & yoga, library visits, swimming, Forest School, cooking or external visitors offering talks and workshops.

Universal funding – 3 & 4 year-olds:

All children receive a universal entitlement of 570 hours per year starting from the term after they turn three.

For **term-time only attendance** this is 15 hours per week offered up to a maximum of six hours per day.

Additional hours entitlement – 2, 3 & 4 year-olds:

For eligible families, the government now offers 1140 hours across the year.

For **term-time only attendance** this is 30 hours per week offered up to a maximum of six hours per day.

Funding can be used during the afternoon sessions only, starting at 12pm. Additional voluntary charges will apply for meals and snacks provided during this time.

Parents are required to provide nappies, wipes and sun cream.

Non-funded hours are charged per session.

Completion of a Parent Declaration Form is required before funding can be claimed.

To access funding, you will need to ensure you have a valid code from the beginning of the term your child wishes to join nursery. Funding terms start on 1st September, 1st January and 1st April. It is parents' responsibility to reconfirm their details every three months to keep their code valid and continue accessing funding throughout the year.
