## Year 1 – Summer Term Visits and Events

As part of our curriculum during the Summer Term, we will be taking the Year 1 children on a number of exciting visits and events to help bring our learning to life. We are very much looking forward to sharing these rich experiences with the children and are sure they will create many lasting memories.

### Avoncroft Museum of Historic Buildings – Tuesday 21st April

To link with our topic work, we will be visiting Avoncroft Museum of Historic Buildings for the day. During our visit, the children will explore the museum site and take part in two hands-on workshops: *wattle and daub* and *brick making*. Lunch will be provided.

### Forest School Morning with King's St Alban's – Thursday 7th May

Children from King's St Alban's will be joining us at King's Hawford for a Forest School morning. This will be a lovely opportunity for the children to share their love of the outdoors with new friends. A packed lunch will be provided.

### Swan Theatre Visit – Thursday 14th May

To support our English work, we will be visiting the Swan Theatre to watch a performance of *A Squash and a Squeeze*. Children will have lunch at school as usual before we leave.

### Droitwich Houses Study – Monday 18th May

We will be heading to Droitwich for the morning to complete a houses study, linking with our topic work. We will return to school in time for a normal lunch.

### Bishop's Wood Forest School Visit – Thursday 4th June

The children will visit Bishop's Wood for the day to experience Forest School at a different site. A packed lunch will be provided.

### Multi-Sports Morning at Sling Pool Walk – Wednesday 24th June

We will be visiting Sling Pool Walk for a joint multi-sports morning with King's St Alban's. The children will enjoy a picnic lunch before returning to school.

### Year 1 Fantastic Finish Beach Party – Tuesday 7th July

Our Summer Term will conclude with our Year 1 *Fantastic Finish* beach party. While the beach is a little too far away, we will be bringing the magic of the Great British seaside to Hawford! The bottom field will be transformed into our very own '**Hawford-on-Sea**', complete with sandcastle building, water play and traditional seaside games such as boules, bat and ball, and French cricket. The children will also enjoy ice cream, bouncy castles and a magic show. Children may bring 'beach' clothes to change into after our Pre-Prep Speech Day. A picnic lunch will be provided.
