

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Clubs and Activities – Summer Term 2026

Please find attached the Summer Term early morning, lunchtime and after-school clubs and activities list. All children from Reception to Year 6 will need to book into a club or elect to go home at the end of each school day. As usual, early morning, lunchtime and after school clubs are bookable via the online form.

You will see that we have provided menus with a brief overview of the clubs on offer for each age group. You will also find flyers for some clubs run by external providers, which will give further details in regard to dates and prices. Clubs run by external providers, that require payment, can be booked in the same way and payment should be made via the School Gateway (www.schoolgateway.com), as soon as possible, to secure a place. A list will then be produced and given to the providers. Please ensure that payments for all clubs are made before the start of term.

Clubs with a maximum limit, will be filled on a first-come-first-served basis; if payment is taken and your child does not make the list, payment will be refunded.

'Homework' Club, from Monday to Thursday, will again be run as a bookable session for children in Years 3-6. We will also continue to offer clubs with 'Stay and Play' Club for Pre-Prep. Both clubs will also be available for those children who remain in school but who are not booked into clubs. Children can be collected at any time from these sessions. The Stay & Play finishes at 4-45pm and Homework Club at 5-00pm.

You will see on the Summer Term Activities sheet that there is a club available for each year group every evening. clubs finish at 4-45pm for Reception to Year 2 and at 5-00pm for Years 3 to 6 (unless otherwise stated). After these times, children will be taken to Late Club, which will be located on the Hard Surface or in N1 for Years 1 to 6 and in Kindergarten for Reception children.

Where children in Years 5 & 6 have been asked to attend production rehearsals (please refer to Mrs Hughes schedule) this will take precedence over attending clubs.
