

ENGLISH

In Year 1 children will have daily phonics and English sessions. These will link with the key texts listed below.

KEY TEXTS:

The Three Little Pigs, Traditional Tale, The True Story of the Three Little Pigs by Jon Scieszka, A Squash and a Squeeze by Julia Donaldson, Home by Carrson Ellis, Billy's Bucket by Kes Grey and Gary Parsons, The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch by David Armitage.

In English this term we will continue to work on developing our sentence writing learning how to use connectives to extend sentences when appropriate. Children will continue to be encouraged to work more independently; orally rehearsing sentences before writing, using resources available to support writing and checking and editing work once finished. Children will be grouped for phonics and will work on filling gaps in sound knowledge as highlighted in Spring assessments.

The children will have opportunity to explore and write newspapers, character descriptions, poems, information texts, adverts, and stories.

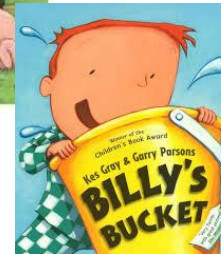
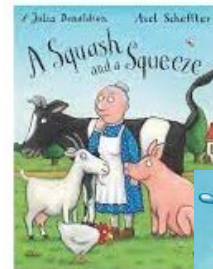
