

Year 2 Summer Term Chess



Dear Parents & Guardians,

I am pleased to advise you that there will be a lunchtime Chess Club for Year 2 children in the Summer Term. The club will be open to those children just starting Chess, as well as those who already know how to play.

Each half hour session will include teaching for those new to Chess and also some time for children to play matches or mini games. Sessions will include teaching on various subjects such as moving the Knight correctly, castling and checkmate.

The aim is for children to learn the correct rules of Chess and how to become good players and at the same time have fun taking part!

Many of the young Chess players who took part in Year 2's Chess group last year are still enjoying playing Chess at lunchtime and making excellent progress.

Chess Club for Year 2 children will start on Thursday 23rd April and continue until Thursday 25th June. The cost for the Summer course will be £60 and this must be paid via the [School Gateway](#).

Your child will need to sign up for Chess for a term at a time, although they are free to attend the first session on a trial basis.
