

Dear Parents & Guardians,

To support this term's topic 'Wicked Worcester', we have organised several visits to allow the children to explore the city that they live in. The following trips have been organised:

Tuesday 2nd June 2026 – Our 'Wicked Worcester' tour will start at the cathedral in the morning. The children will have a guided tour of the historical building followed up with activities in the learning centre. We will then visit KSW for our lunch break. In the afternoon, a second tour will take place (led by a guide from Discover Worcester) allowing us to visit all of the main landmarks within the city centre. At 2:30pm, the children will walk along the River Severn and finish back at the Senior School, where the minibuses will be located, to return to school.

Thursday 4th June 2026 - Unlocking the Severn which is located at Diglis Island. The children will have the opportunity to learn about the Canal & River Trust UtS project, which will include a guided fish passes walk, water safety activities and an epic engineering workshop to help understand how canals work. We intend to leave school at 9:30am and return by 2:30pm.

Please ensure your child has a **warm, waterproof coat** as some of the activities will be outside, a refillable drinks bottle and sun cream applied to cater for all weather. Packed lunches and snacks will be provided for both visits.

For both trips it will cost £7 per child. Please visit the school's online gateway by following link www.schoolgateway.com to provide consent for both trips. Please ensure that payment has been made by Friday 15th May.
